2018 SNOOKER SINGLES TOURNAMENT

SATURDAY 12TH MAY AND 19TH MAY

Who is eligible to play? The event is open to all MSBA and Southern registered members who are currently competing in the 2018 Summer Snooker Season. Members not currently competing in this year's Snooker competition may apply to enter, subject to availability of a starting position. There is a maximum of 32 entrants. **The entry fee is \$5** payable on arrival.

Where and when will the Competition be held? The Singles Tournament for the first week, 12th May, will be held over four clubs, North Brighton, Camberwell Cue Sports, Burwood and Grace Hawthorn. The Finals will be played the following Saturday, 19th May, at a venue or venues to be decided.

How to enter the Competition? Please advise the MSBA Secretary, Steve Balmford or the President, Errol Aristodemou by e-mail or phone by Sunday 6th May. When applying to enter please provide an e-mail address or phone number as we will need to contact you prior to the event to advise where you are playing and at what time.

What handicaps will apply? There will be two divisions with 50% in the low handicap division and 50% in the high handicap division. The players' handicaps after round 14 will generally apply. The MSBA officials have full discretion in deciding the most appropriate handicap. Their decision is final and no discussion will be entered into regarding handicaps.

How will the draw be decided? A MSBA representative will draw player's names out of a hat.

How are the results to be notified? On completion of each game, the players are to jointly advise the MSBA representative their game result as soon as it is completed.

What are the prizes? There is \$1000.00 in prize money.

The following cash prizes will be awarded and presented to the following players on 19th May

Tournament winner-\$400 (and individual trophy)	Runner Up- \$200
Losing Semi Finalists (2)- \$100	Losing quarter finalists (4)- \$50

The winner's trophy will be presented at the MSBA Presentation Night on 31st July 2018.

Are there any special rules? All members entering the competition will agree to abide by the rules and conditions of the competition and the MSBA by-laws. Any player arriving 15 minutes late will forfeit the first frame. After a further 15 minutes the match is forfeited.
