FAX

Both Captains must fax results to 9690 7433 before close of business the next day, please fax as early as possible. If results are not received by 6.00 pm the following day the offending team will be penalised one match point.

Captains Duties

1. Each team captain shall complete details of his/her team including names and handicaps on the Score Sheet.
2. Then add details to opposing teams Score Sheet.
3. When match is completed both captains shall verify both Score Sheets details. Names, handicaps, scores, breaks 20 and higher, etc. and sign both Score Sheets.
4. Any mistake in handicap and the offending team will be penalised 2 match points.
5. Each team captain must then fax the result to 9690 7433 24 hour service
6. The home team captain must supply a Score Sheet for the visiting captain.

Calculating match results

Summer and Spring Snooker:

1. Add the points scored for all games to determine the Total Points.
2. Add up the number of frames won by each team and write in box to left of Match Points.
3. Number of Frames won equals Match Points PLUS %
4. To determine the %, calculate the difference between each teams Total Points.
5. The difference is then added to the Match Points of the Team with highest Total Points as a decimal %.

Example:	Tot.Pnts	Frms	Mch.Pts
Home Team	648	4	4
Visiting Team	697	4	4.49
Total Points Difference	49	= WINNER = VISITORS	

Spring Billiards:

1. Add the points scored for all games to determine the Total Points.
2. Add up the number of games won and multiply by 2 to determine the Match Points.
3. Calculate the difference between each teams Total Points and halve the result. This becomes the % difference to calculate the overall Match Points.
4. The difference is then added to the Match Points of the Team with highest Total Points as a decimal %.

Example:	Tot.Pnts	Games	Mch.Pts
Home Team	1076	2	4.38
Visiting Team	1000	2	4
Total Points Difference	76	= WINNER = HOME TEAM
