

# Victorian RSL Billiards & Snooker Association

## DRESS CODE

### **Rule 6.2 of the Association's Rules states:**

“All players and visiting supporters shall adhere to the current general dress standards for RSL clubs at all times during representative play, irrespective of the actual venue at which a match takes place. **Any player nominated on the match score sheet shall not be permitted to take part in competitive play whilst contravening these dress standards.** In any situation where it is considered that a player does not meet these dress standards, Team captains shall include an appropriate notation outlining the circumstances on the score sheet. “

The following guidelines are provided to assist members with their understanding of what is and is not acceptable during representative play.

**All members are obliged to adhere to and uphold the Association's Rules.**

### **SHIRTS**

- must have a collar
- may be in Club colours and/or bear sponsors' logos
- must not be ripped, torn or display offensive slogans or material.

### **SLACKS / JEANS / SHORTS**

- must be of neat casual appearance
- must not be ripped, torn or display offensive slogans or material
- tracksuit pants (or similar) are not permitted.

### **FOOTWEAR / SOCKS**

- must be of a neat casual appearance
- must not be ripped or torn
- sandals may be worn with long socks
- ankle socks are permitted **ONLY** if worn with long trousers
- multi-coloured or holed runners are not permitted
- thongs are not permitted.

### **HATS / CAPS**

- are not acceptable items of clothing worn in RSL clubs
- visors are permitted whilst actively playing billiards or snooker.
