

VBSA RANKINGS EXPLAINED

SNOOKER RANKING POINTS

Ranking points for snooker & billiards are earned in the following ways and form the basis of the VBSA official snooker ranking list. Rankings are updated at the completion of every Tournament and at the completion of each season. At the start of the calendar year all points from the previous year are faded by 50%.

1. MAIN SNOOKER SEASON

Super League, Premier & Reserve Grades Season

Super League	120 points per frame won
A Premier	100 points per frame won
B Premier	60 points per frame won
B Reserve	40 points per frame won
C Premier	40 points per frame won
C Reserve	30 points per frame won
D Premier	25 points per frame won
D Reserve	20 points per frame won

Super League, Willis & Reserve Grades Season

Half of the above ranking points to be awarded.

2. TOURNAMENT PLAY

There are major snooker tournaments held each year all carrying VBSA ranking points.

- Kings Australia Cup = 50 points per frame won
- The Lance Pannell Classic (Yarraville) = 50 points per frame won
- The Princes Cup Tournament = 50 points per frame won
- Fred Osbourne Memorial Classic (Albury) = 50 points per frame won
- The City of Melbourne Tournament = 50 points per frame won
- The Victorian Snooker Championship = 50 points per frame won
- For entering any of the above tournaments = 200 points

In all tournaments points are doubled at the last 16 stage through to the final if entry exceeds 64, or at the last 8 stage if entries exceed 32

3. CALCULATION OF RANKING POINTS

Points are added to the ranking list at the end of each calendar year, all ranking points for all players for the previous year will be faded by 50% at the same time.

BILLIARDS RANKING POINTS

Ranking points for billiards are earned in the following ways and form the basis of the VBSA official billiards ranking list.

1. BILLIARDS SEASON

Premier Billiards

A grade	= 100 points per match won
B, C grade	= 50 points per match won

2. VICTORIAN BILLIARDS TOURNAMENT

For every point scored in the competition 1 ranking point will be awarded.

3. CALCULATION OF RANKING POINTS

Points are added to the ranking list at the end of each calendar year, all ranking points for all players for the previous year will be faded by 50% at the same time.

NOTE: Ranking points are only available for home and away matches. There are no ranking points available in any Pennant finals matches
