Series Playoff - at Kings Entertainment Centre

1. To Enter, you must be a member of the VBSA or an Affiliated Association
2. The top 16 Victorian tournament ranked players are excluded from entering these tournaments. Players may be refused entry at the discretion of the Board of the VBSA.
3. Dress Code: As you would dress for a pennant match, slacks, collared shirt or Club monogrammed polo top, leather shoes.
4. Players must check in 15 minutes prior to their match start time.

Handicap Series playoff

Players that participate in any or all of the 4 Handicap Tournaments played in any year:

Will be awarded points on the basis of:
for entering 2 Points.
+ 1 Point per Frame won.

All points accrued by players will be added and the top 16 points holders at the end of the 4 tournaments will be invited to play in a final series with \$2500 prize money. (Entry to the final series will be Free)

A ladder of "Points Standings" will be published after each tournament so players can strive to gain a top 16 position. If two or more players are tied at 16th position then all players in the tie will be invited to play.

Any player that has entered all 4 tournaments will go into the final.

Players must compete in at least 2 of the tournaments to qualify for the final.

The final will be held at a date and time to be fixed by the board, all players qualified will be notified.
