## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY – KINGS AUSTRALIA CUP

1. The tournament is a Sanctioned National Ranking tournament and is open to all players. All players to play off scratch.
2. The seeding of the tournament will be done in conjunction with the Australian Billiards and Snooker Council.
3. All entrants must agree to abide by the Conditions of Play laid down by the Tournament Committee. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to accept or refuse any entry.
4. Players (including interstate players) outside the top 32 may be required to play on Friday.
5. Entries will only be accepted if they are on the official entry form, accompanied by the entry fee and received by the closing date for entries. Entries received after the closing date will not be accepted.
6. All players to comply with ABSC Code of Ethics during this tournament.

## CONDITIONS OF PLAY – KINGS AUSTRALIA CUP

1. Competitors shall be in attendance at least 15 minutes before the designated starting time of his/her match. Any competitor not ready to commence play at the designated starting time shall immediately lose one frame. Any competitor not ready to commence play 15 minutes after the designated starting time shall forfeit the match. Once the opening matches are underway the roll on system will come into effect.
2. Players must comply with the following dress standard: dark colored tailored slacks, dress shoes, long-sleeved plain-coloured shirt buttoned at the wrist with a waistcoat **and** a bow tie (straight tie is not acceptable). Note: A sleeveless pullover is not acceptable as a waistcoat. Incorrectly attired players shall forfeit the right to play.
3. The losing player from each game played is to act as referee for the game following on the same table, provided that any alternative arrangement agreed by both the player concerned and the tournament director may be substituted.
