CONDITIONS

- * The tournament is a National Ranking tournament and is open to all players.
- * All players to comply with ABSC Code of Ethics during this tournament.
- * Competitors shall be in attendance at least 15 minutes before the designated starting time of his/her match. Any competitor not ready to commence play at the designated starting time shall immediately lose one frame. Any competitor not ready to commence play 15 minutes after the designated starting time shall forfeit the match. Once the opening matches are underway the rotation system will come into effect.
- * Players must comply at all times during the tournament with the following dress standard: dark colored tailored slacks and dress shoes, long-sleeved plain-coloured shirt, waistcoat and bow tie.
Note: A sleeveless pullover is not acceptable as a waistcoat. Incorrectly attired players shall forfeit the right to play.
- * The losing player from each game played is to act as referee for the game following on the same table, provided that any alternative arrangement agreed by both the player concerned and the tournament director may be substituted.

NOTES

- * The draw has been seeded and scheduled by the ABSC and the top 16 seeds are seeded to the round of 32.
- * All players entered into the competition are automatically in the draw for a TV and DVD player valued at \$500. The draw will be done at the conclusion of the final match on the Sunday. Only players present are eligible to win the draw prize.
- * All qualifying matches will be played on Friday 9th October, 2009 at 7:00 pm
- * Entry to Consolation Plate event is \$10 - Total prizemoney for the plate is \$500

HISTORY

- * **Robby FOLDVARI** is the most successful player in the history of this tournament having won this event on four separate occasions. In the late 1990's Foldvari won the Princes Cup three years in succession. Then, after a seven year absence from the winner's circle, Foldvari again appeared in last year's final. On that occasion he defeated first time finalist, Daniel Thorp 4-0 in a one-sided match. In this year's tournament, Foldvari is the number one seed.
