



VBSA 2010 Tournament entry and conditions

To enter any of the tournaments that are run by the VBSA you **MUST**

Be a member of the VBSA or an affiliated Association. Entries will only be accepted if they are on the official entry form (Page 2 of this document), accompanied by the entry fee and received by the closing date for entries. **ENTRIES WILL CLOSE 2 WEEKS BEFORE THE TOURNAMENT.**

- There are 2 ways to enter a VBSA run tournament.
 - By post – money order or cheque
 - By paypal – go to the VBSA website and follow the paypal link

Dress Code for VBSA run Ranking Tournaments

(a) Dark coloured dress slacks or trousers, black leather dress shoes, long sleeved shirt of the type that would be worn with a tie or bow tie. If a sleeveless vest, or a waistcoat is worn then wearing a bow tie is optional

(b) Players must present themselves in a neat and tidy manner at all times during the match.

E.g. shirt must be tucked in and bow tie, if worn, be worn correctly

(Penalty: incorrectly dressed players shall not be permitted to play).

Dress Code for VBSA Handicap Tournaments

The minimum dress standard is: Slacks, Collared shirt or Polo shirt (preferably a club shirt) and leather shoes, however under no circumstances shall any of the following articles of clothing be acceptable: thongs, jeans, cargo pants, T-shirts, shorts, cords, sandals, sandshoes, tracksuits, or sports shoes. (Penalty: incorrectly dressed players shall not be permitted to play).

Tournament Rules

- Competitors shall be in attendance at least 15 minutes before the designated starting time of his/her match. Any competitor not ready to commence play at the designated starting time shall immediately lose one frame. Any competitor not ready to commence play 15 minutes after the designated starting time shall forfeit the match.
- Losing players must referee or pay \$30. Any player breaching this condition may be fined \$50 or denied entry to further tournaments.
- All entrants must agree to abide by the Conditions of Play laid down by the VBSA. The VBSA reserve the right to accept or refuse any entry.
- All players to comply with ABSC Code of Ethics.
