

By Laws for Super League (Played within Pennant & Willis A Grade)

Team Nominations

Teams must be nominated prior to the scheduled closing date for the start of the Premier or Willis season. Team nomination must include contact numbers for Super League Players.

Super League Player Nominations

Each team may nominate one player as Super League participant. Players nominated as Super League players must play as per the Super League fixture. Super League players will fill position 1 only, in their nominated team.

Scores

Frame scores will count as 1 point per frame won. Points will count for both Super League individual Scores and for the Willis team score. Ladders will be published for both Super League and A grade teams.

Reserves

If a Super League player is not available on the night then a player that normally plays with that team in positions 2, 3, 4 or as a reserve may play in the Super League position. The reserves frame wins will be scored in the Premier or Willis competition only, the Super League player that plays against a reserve will score 2 points (irrespective of the match score on the night) in the Super League Ladder. Frame wins by the Super League player playing against a reserve will score for the Premier or Willis Team ladder only.

Eligibility

For any Super League player to qualify for finals they must have played at least 80% of all scheduled matches (matches played against a reserve will count).

Super League Finals

The top players by the Super League ladder will participate in a final series. This final series will be played in one day on a designated date, and at a designated venue, at the end of the season. The dress code for the final series will be the same as weekly pennant matches.

Perpetual Trophy – John Mc Kay Shield.

Televised Matches

In the advent of a major sponsor being gained for the Super League, week to week matches may be rescheduled for a venue and a date and time to be fixed so matches can be taped for television. If a match is rescheduled the players will play their scheduled match on pennant night, this match will only count for the pennant scores. The rescheduled match will be counted for Super League scores.

The VB&SA reserve the right to accept or refuse team nominations. Any team refused entry has the right to appeal to the full Board of the VB&SA.
