Event Details, Terms and Conditions

Schedule

We need your cooperation as any delays to the full schedule will cascade into a very long day for everyone and we wish to make this as positive an experience as possible.

The first 3 matches start at 9am. There will be a summary run-through of the key aspects of the day and other important information just before play starts so, you must be there no later than 15 minutes before the start of the day. Each round starting on the hour each hour with a 10-minute break between each

All players must report to the Tournament Director or their Deputy on arrival and be ready to play their match at least 15 minutes before their match.

All players are expected to be in attendance at least 15 minutes before the start of their scheduled games. Any player not in attendance and ready to play at the designated start time, their opponent will gain 30 points when referee calls the game to commence. If a player is not in attendance 15 minutes after the designated start time their game shall be declared a walkover given to their opponent and the scores reflect 0-50 with the 50 points going to their opponent.

If you need to leave the venue for any reason, please ask the TD first to ensure this does not cause any scheduling issues. If you are not at the table at the commencement of your next match the above rule will apply

All disputes will be referred to the Tournament Director and/or Director of Referees and their decision will be final.

Format

Format is all 6 players are playing at the start of the hour for 5 hours. Playing each person once for 50 minutes. If there is a draw, the seedings will be determined by percentage of points for/against.

Dress Code
